


Thinking of adding a **funeral notices embedded feed** to your website?

Funeral notices embedded feed best practice

To become an online partner you need to have a link to your new funeral notices embedded feed page on the main navigation menu of your website on both desktop and mobile, ideally not on a drop-down menu as people are less likely to find and interact with it making it harder for the new page to attract new visitors to your website.

Your funeral notices embedded feed can be customised to fit in with the style of your website. Whether you are adding the funeral notices embedded feed yourself or asking a web developer to do it for you, you'll need to take a look at the options below and choose how you would like your funeral notices feed to look:

Option 1 - Square style notice



Option 2 - Rounded style notice

Notice classification footer | option to include the type of notice at the bottom



Notice uploaded date | option to display the date the notice was published



Notice hometown and notable areas | option to display the area the notice relates to

Don't worry if you do not know the exact colours you require as our team can check your website and select matching colours for you.






Notice search bar functionality options
